



RULES

- 1. All students from the IES Eugeni d'Ors (ESO and batxillerat) are allowed to take part in the contest.
- 2. All writings in English, either prose or poetry, must be original and they must be handed in to any member of the foreign language department on the 24th of February at the latest.
- 3. The length of the writings cannot exceed two sheets.
- 4. All students must hand in 2 copies of their writings in a big envelope, with the pseudonym of the author on its front side. In the same envelope, a smaller envelope with the name of the author and group must also be included. (They can be handed in at Consergeria, or to any English teacher).
- 5. Levels and prizes:

• A Level: 1st, 2nd ESO and 3rd ESO

• B Level: 4th ESO, batxillerat and cicles

At each level there will be a first prize of 40 € and a second prize of 20 €.

- 6. Awards will be delivered during the ceremony that will take place on the 21st April.
- 7. All awarded writings are likely to be published on the Eugeni d'Ors digital magazine.
- 8. All non-awarded writings can be collected the week after the delivery of the awards.
- 9. The jury consists of the teachers of the English Department.
